What is Miracle League Baseball?

Miracle League baseball is built on five principles:

- Every player bats once each inning
- All base runners are safe
- Every player scores a run before the inning is over (last one up gets a home run)
- Community children and volunteers serve as 'buddies' to assist the players
- Each team and each player wins every game

The Miracle League is also about making new friends, building self-esteem and being treated just like other kids. Miracle League uses a "buddy" system—pairing each player with a volunteer to assist them throughout the game.

Miracle League teams play on a custom-designed, synthetic turf field that accommodates wheelchairs and other assertive devices while helping to prevent injuries such as the existing Miracle Field in Roselle (304 E. Pine St.).
