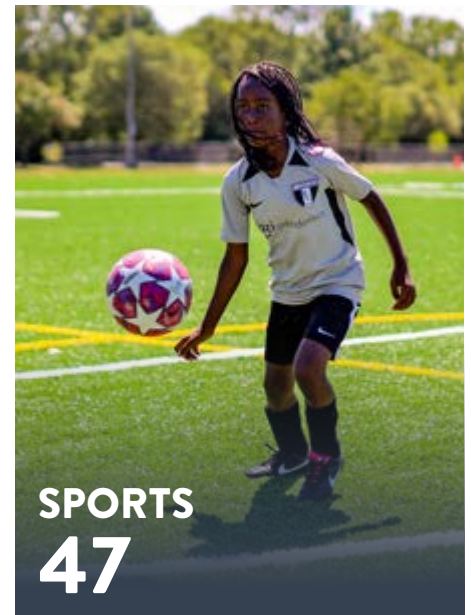

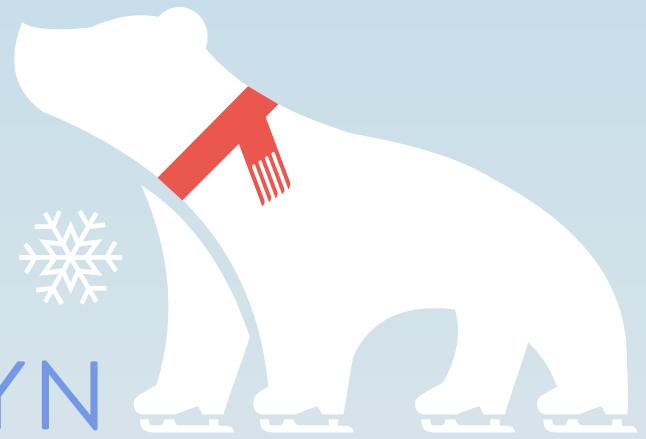

# P GLEN ELLYN POLAR PLAZA

## Downtown Pop-Up Skating Rink



In a partnership with the Village of Glen Ellyn, the Park District is excited to offer ice skating in downtown Glen Ellyn. The synthetic (plastic) ice skating rink is free to residents and visitors to the area and will be open seven days a week from noon to 9 p.m. through March. The pop-up Polar Plaza occupies a portion of the Village's Crescent parking lot, just west of Main Street. Parking is available in the western most portion of the Crescent parking lot.

The Polar Plaza will have a variety of safety precautions and COVID-19 regulations in place to keep visitors safe, including required face coverings and sanitizing stations.

### Skating Rink Rules

- Skate at your own risk
- No hockey or hockey sticks
- If multiple skaters, please skate in one direction
- No street shoes allowed on skating surface
- Food and drink not allowed on skating surface
- Only authorized personnel may perform any maintenance duties including snow removal
- Hours of skating are from noon-9:00 p.m.
- Please be courteous and respectful
- Maximum capacity: 50 skaters
- Not responsible for lost or stolen items

# 2021 Update Sunset Pool

**We look forward to swimming with you this summer!**

Sunset Pool is scheduled to open Saturday, May 29, and remain open through Labor Day. Due to COVID-19, the pool will operate with new safety modifications in alignment with State and local health department guidelines. As mitigations are subject to change, Sunset Pool could have to adjust operations and programs accordingly. Please be sure to check the District's website for updates throughout the season. After being closed for 2020, the Glen Ellyn Park District is committed to making the pool available and accessible while operating in a safe and compliant manner, including offering lap swim, open swim, Gators Swim Team, and other programming. However, while remaining optimistic and resourceful, should the restraints be severe, further consideration and evaluation of the facility by staff and the Board of Commissioners would take place.

# Gators Swim Team

The Gators Swim Team season will run Monday, June 7th to Friday, July 16th.

Gators Swim Team will be modified for the 2021 season to follow safety protocols from State and local health organizations. If regulations permit the safe and efficient operation of a swim team; practice times will be more spread out but will continue to be held on weekday mornings. As the West Suburban Swim Conference will be on hiatus due to the pandemic, intramural meets will be held entirely at Sunset Pool. Registration for Gators will begin at 9am Saturday, March 6, and is first come, first serve.

Gators is a competitive recreational swim team is made up of youth ages 7-18 years. Participants are expected to attend practice Monday-Friday where they will learn the techniques and discipline of competitive swimming, and the value of sportsmanship and team spirit. The swim team will be divided into two teams, "A" which is more competitive and "B" which is for less experienced swimmers. Intramural swim meets will take place at Sunset Pool on Tuesday & Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings. Parents will be asked to volunteer their time at the meets to assist with overall operation. Volunteer information, swim meet details, and signups will be taking place later.

Swim Team is not a lesson program. To have an enjoyable experience and safely take part, 7 and 8 years old must be able to comfortably swim 25-yards of freestyle and 25-yards of backstroke without stopping. Participants over 9 years old must be able to swim 50-yards freestyle and backstroke without stopping. ## Phase 4 Participation Guidelines

- Face coverings are required for all patrons over the age of 2 when entering the facility, exiting the course, or passing other patrons. Inform staff if you have a medical condition that limits your ability to wear a face covering.
- Patrons must wait outside on the social distancing markers if patrons are already in the building
- Please adhere to the entrance and exits signs
- Indoor restrooms are open to mini golf guests only, outdoor restrooms are open to the public
- Only 50 patrons allowed on each course
- No more than 4 players on a hole. Larger groups must split up.

### Phase 4 Participation Guidelines

- 50-person capacity per 1.5-hour session
- Reservations are required for every individual (children and adults) entering the gate and utilizing space.
- Late arrivals: after 15 minutes from the start time, patrons will lose their reserved spot.
- Parties/celebrations are not allowed inside the splash park.
- Face covering must be worn when checking in and when social distancing is not possible.
- Due to COVID-19, no toys, buckets, or cups are allowed in splash park to avoid sharing.
- Please do not use a table unless you are a group of 3 or more. Chairs are available for smaller groups.
- No outside food or coolers are allowed in splash park. Personal water bottles are recommended. Your snack and lunch may be eaten at the pavilion.
- Children under the age of 10 must always have adult supervision.
- Swimsuits and appropriate swim attire required.
- Swim diapers are required for babies that are not toilet trained.
- All persons using the splash park do so at their own risk and sole responsibility.



# Preschool

## Our Philosophy & Curriculum

At our Preschool, children learn through an academic and play-based curriculum to facilitate learning concepts including writing, science, vocabulary, numbers, shapes, math, and other cognitive abilities. The academics incorporated into the program will ensure students are prepared to move to the next level and eventually be Kindergarten-ready.

Our program is a mixture of teacher-guided activities and playtime, with small and large group activities based around a weekly theme. Children engage in fine and large motor skill activities, art projects, music, books, dramatic play, cooking, writing and more. Children also have monthly visits from B#Sharp Music for Children and the Park District Naturalist.

### 2-Year-Olds *Age 2 as of 6/15/21*

Geared toward having a successful first school-away-from-parent experience while preparing for the three-year-old program. Emphasis is placed on socialization skills and introduction to a structured class.

### 3-Year-Olds *Age 3 as of 9/1/21*

Geared toward having a successful first school experience. Emphasis is placed on social skills, fine motor skills, shapes, colors, name recognition, following direction, sharing and play. Must be able to use the restroom independently.

### 4-Year-Olds *Age 4 as of 9/1/21*

Designed for developing kindergarten readiness. Emphasis is placed on the development of academics through structured activities, introducing math, lower/upper case letters, letter sound recognition, writing/site words, and developing independence. Must be able to use the restroom independently.

### 5-Year-Olds

**Must turn 5 between 9/1/21-1/1/22**

Designed for developing kindergarten readiness. Emphasis is placed on the development of academics through structured activities, simple math, lower/upper case letters, letter sound recognition, writing/site words, punctuation, capitalization, problem solving and developing independence.

## Registration

**Open registration is now in progress.**

Registration will be for the complete school year and must be done in person at either the Spring Avenue or Main Street Recreation Centers. Parents must submit a copy of their child's birth certificate at the time of their registration.

## Schedule

The 2021-2022 preschool year begins the week of September 7, 2021 and concludes the week of May 13, 2022. Classes will not meet on legal public holidays as determined by the District 41 school calendar. There may be additional dates, which will be stated in your Glen Ellyn Park District Preschool Calendar.

## Payment

Preschool uses automatic billing/payments. A separate nonrefundable deposit of \$75 will be required upon registration. The yearly class fee is divided into six equal amounts charged to your credit card or e-check each month May-October. You may also pay for the entire year at registration.

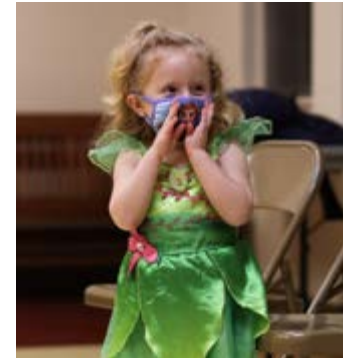

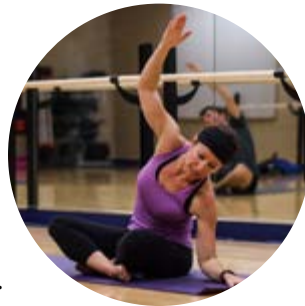

## Dance for Kids

Our professional instructors inspire creativity, teach core dance concepts, and give students a strong foundation in quality dance technique and vocabulary. ### Parent/Tot Dance

Designed for our littlest dancers, this class introduces basic ballet, coordination, and gross motor skills through creative movement and interactive songs with a parent present. Ballet shoes are optional for parent/caregiver.

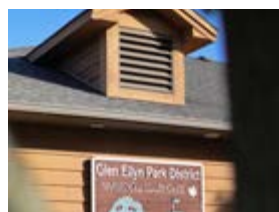

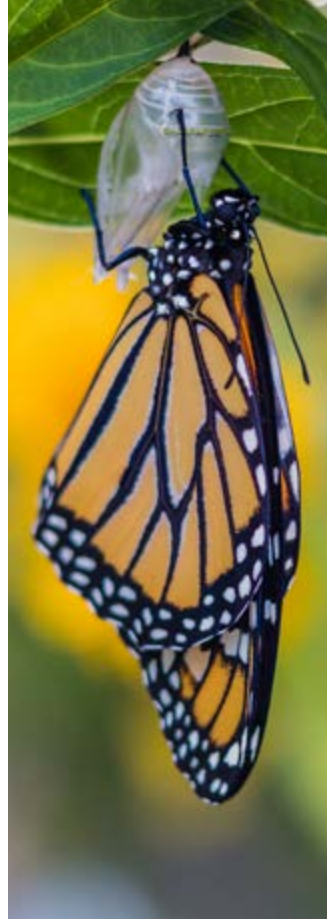

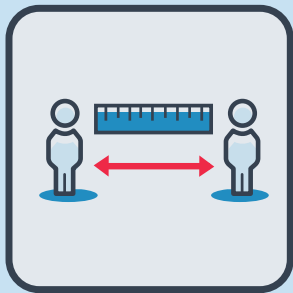

# DISTRICT POLICIES

## DEFINITION OF RESIDENCY

Not all Glen Ellyn residents are in the Park District. Anyone living within the geographic boundaries of the Glen Ellyn Park District is considered a resident. Glen Ellyn Park District residents, via property taxes, make financial contributions to the operation of the park system. Non-residents are charged higher fees for programs than residents to compensate for property tax disparity.

Residents of Glen Ellyn who are not residents of the Glen Ellyn Park District or any other park district may receive all the privileges of belonging to the Glen Ellyn Park District by paying the equivalent of Park District taxes annually. This membership allows for priority registration, pool passes, and any other services provided to our residents at the resident rate.

## WAIVERS OF LIABILITY

To participate in any Glen Ellyn Park District program, you must sign a waiver releasing the Park District of any liability.

## REFUNDS, CANCELLATIONS

The Glen Ellyn Park District reserves the right to cancel, postpone or combine classes, or change instructors. If insufficient enrollment causes a class to be canceled, notification will be given 7 days in advance, and full tuition refunded. Withdrawals prior to the start of a class will be assessed at minimum a \$5.00 service charge. Refunds for moving, injury/illness, or schedule changes will be pro-rated according to the date the request for a refund is made.

## COMMITMENT TO QUALITY

To encourage first time participation as well as repeat participation, the Park District has a refund policy highlighted by a satisfaction guarantee. This special refund policy provides us with timely feedback about dissatisfaction regarding our services. We can then take prompt action to improve services. If you are not completely satisfied, tell us and we will either: invite you to repeat the class at no charge; allow you a credit that can be applied to another program; issue you a full refund.

Our guarantee is based on fulfilling our promise to deliver the published expectations describing the service you have used. A refund will be granted if you were dissatisfied with the experience due to circumstances under the Park District's control.

Requests for the above-mentioned options must be made before the midpoint of the program or within two weeks of a single meeting activity. All refund requests must be submitted in writing and returned to the Spring Avenue Recreation Center or the Main Street Recreation Center. Satisfaction Guarantee does not apply to trips, special events with prepaid admissions and tickets, and athletic programs where equipment has already been ordered.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Glen Ellyn Park District recognizes there are community residents who may suffer economic setbacks that might preclude their participation in Glen Ellyn Park District programs. Financial assistance forms are available at the Spring Avenue and Main Street Recreation Center. All requests remain confidential. Questions? Contact Kimberly Dikker at (630) 942-7256.

A referral for additional scholarship assistance is also available to qualified resident children under the age of 18 through the Milton Township Youth Committee's Family Youth Scholarship Fund.

## INSURANCE

The Glen Ellyn Park District does not provide medical insurance coverage for individuals who participate in our programs or use our facilities. To do so would make programs and user fees cost prohibitive.

## AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) prohibits discrimination on the basis of a disability. The Glen Ellyn Park District will make reasonable accommodations in recreation programs to enable participation by an individual with a disability that meets essential eligibility requirements for that leisure program and facility.

## NON-DISCRIMINATION STATEMENT

The Glen Ellyn Park District prohibits discrimination in all its programs and activities on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender, religion, age, disability, political beliefs, sexual orientation, marital or family status.

## BEHAVIOR POLICY

Participants are always expected to exhibit appropriate behavior. The following guidelines have been developed to help make Park District programs safe and enjoyable for all participants. Additional rules may be developed for specific programs and athletic leagues as deemed necessary by staff. Participants shall:

1. Show respect to all participants and staff, take direction from staff.
2. Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
3. Refrain from causing bodily harm to self, other participants or staff.
4. Show respect for equipment, supplies and facilities.

A positive approach will be used regarding discipline. Staff will periodically review rules with participants during the program session. If inappropriate behavior occurs, prompt resolution will be sought specific to each individual situation. The Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers the safety of themselves or others.

## PARENT'S CODE OF ETHICS

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for players, coaches, and officials at every game and practice.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach.
- I will remember that the game is for youth – not adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability.
- I agree with these rules and understand that the Glen Ellyn Park District Associations have adopted a Zero-Tolerance Policy and that not abiding by these rules may restrict me from attending future games and practices.

## PETS AT EVENTS

The Glen Ellyn Park District asks that everyone please exercise good judgment and leave pets at home when attending events that draw large crowds. Please show respect for other people, yourself and your pet by helping the Park District maintain a safe and healthy environment where all people have the opportunity to participate and enjoy themselves.

To provide the best services, programs and facilities to the public, the Park District reserves the right to add, to change, modify or delete any program or policies after they have been published. The Park District will attempt to make a reasonable effort to give prompt public notice of any material changes in the programs and policies, but notice cannot be assured. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your understanding and cooperation.
