Newton Park Parking

GOAL:

Develop parking/traffic plan along with education/implementation process that will significantly reduce, if not, eliminate, parking/traffic impact on the six (6) cul de sacs while positively effecting inappropriate driving habits around park perimeter.

PRESENT CONDITIONS:

Park users are directed to park in legal areas within and around Newton Park. This is consistent with other similar locations within Glen Ellyn, including Glenbard West High School, all District 41 Schools, and local churches.

On occasion, some of the cul de sacs experience excessive parking within their area, particularly Nicoll, Milton and Montclair. Additionally, inappropriate driving habits occur including turnarounds within driveways and cul de sacs, excessive speed and drop-off and pick-up on Fairview Avenue.

Once becoming aware (September 22, 2016), the Park District monitored parking practices within the Newton Park area through the end of October. During that period, the District did not attempt to effect existing parking and driving habits. The results of these observations are in Addendum A.

PROGRAMMING:

Based on observations and park programming, the District has identified three (3) levels of park activity and potential impact on surrounding neighborhood:

Passive: No organized activities scheduled in the park. Use of amenities in park is self-directed.

Active: General scheduled use of park inclusive of practices. Activities are primarily non-

competitive in nature with spectator participation minimal. Participants are usually dropped off prior to the beginning of the activity and picked up after conclusion of the

activity.

Peak: Sustained use with three or more games played in succession on multiple fields, special

events (regardless of the number of games) and activities such as football equipment

pick-up/drop-off and evaluation week.

Primarily weekends from April through mid-June and August through mid-November.

Recommended Parking Plan

PARK SIGNAGE:

Newton Park activity parking will be directed to designated areas only.

Parking Lot Directional Signage

- (1) 3' x 6' Wooden Frame w/Vinyl Sign at entrance to east lot off of Fairview
- (1) 3' x 6' Wooden Frame w/Vinyl Sign at entrance to west lot off of Fairview

(8) 24" x 18" Metal Sign on Pole along Fairview





PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF OUR NEIGHBORS

- DROP-OFF/PICK-UP IS PROHIBITED ALONG FAIRVIEW AVENUE AND IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD CUL DE SACS. PARTICIPANTS SHOULD BE DROPPED OFF OR PICKED UP IN ONE OF THE DESIGNATED PARKING LOTS.
- PARKING ON THE GRASS OR IN AN UNMARKED SPOT IS PROHIBITED.

Important Game Day Parking Information


Program (Golden Eagles, Glen Ellyn Rugby, Bulldogs Lacrosse, Glen Ellyn Youth Baseball, etc) home games are played at Newton Park (Directions).

Parking lots for all home games are located within Newton Park:

- Northwest corner of the park adjacent to the playground (Fairview Avenue & Exmoor Avenue)
- Northeast corner of the park adjacent to the tennis courts (Fairview Avenue & Carleton Avenue)
- West side of the park adjacent to the basketball court (Carleton Avenue)
- South side of the park across from Brookdale Glen Ellyn (DuPage Avenue)

Additional parking is available at Stahelin Properties to the south of the park off of DuPage Boulevard.

Please be respectful of the neighbors and use the Newton Park lots for parking. DO NOT park on side streets or culd de sacs in the neighborhood. Police will ticket any parking violators.



Park users will be directed not to park or use the cul de sacs for drop-off/pick-up or turn around within the following cul de sacs:

- N. Milton Avenue
- Montclair Avenue
- Nicoll Avenue
- Taylor Avenue
- Carleton Avenue
- Exmoor Avenue

Program Participant Parking/Drop-off/Pick-up Acknowledgement Form

Drop-off/Pick-up is prohibited along Fairview Avenue and in the neighborhood cul de sacs. Participants should be dropped off or picked up in one of the designated parking lots.

Program participants in Golden Eagles Football, Bulldogs Lacrosse, Glen Ellyn Youth Rugby and Glen Ellyn Youth Baseball shall be provided parking and pick-up/drop-off information, including a map of designated areas and sign an online acknowledgement form indicating that they have received when registering. Included will be a reminder to respect neighbors surrounding the park.

Repeated violations may result in suspension from practice and/or games.

MONITORING:

Park District staff/off-duty police/volunteers/park ranger will direct patrons to appropriate parking and provide assistance during periods of peak use (i.e. multiple games, special events, equipment pick-up/drop-off) primarily on Saturdays and Sundays from April through early June and August through early November.

Sustained use shall be defined as three or more games played in succession, special events (regardless of the number of games) and activities such as equipment pick-up and drop-off and evaluation week.

In addition, during the first two weeks of each season, Park District staff/off-duty police/volunteers/park ranger will also direct patrons to appropriate parking and drop-off/pick-up locations during scheduled practice times.

Each street immediately surrounding Newton Park shall designate a block captain to assist with communication between the Park District, Glen Ellyn Police and Neighborhood Parking Committee.

Glenbard West

School Bus parking related to park usage is limited to the northeast lot (Fairview Avenue & Carleton Avenue). No idling of buses is permitted. If parking is limited, buses will be directed to park at the Spring Avenue Recreation Center, Sunset Pool or Baker Hill properties during practices/games.

Glenbard West will be directed to provide parking information to spectators and visiting teams for games and asked to provide staffing to monitor parking.

PARK ETIQUETTE:

Park rules and expectations include, but are not limited to the following:

- Drop-off/pick-up is prohibited along Fairview Avenue and in the neighborhood cul de sacs. Participants should be dropped off or picked up in one of the designated parking lots.
- Parking in the grass or in an unmarked spot is prohibited.
- Excessive vehicular noise is prohibited.
- Dogs must be on a leash. Please pick up and properly dispose of all dog waste.
- Dispose of trash and recyclables in appropriate receptacles.

PHYSICAL IMPROVEMENTS:

- Pathway connection from east parking lot to pathway system in park (2017)
- West lot turnaround (2017)
- Reconfiguration of basketball court, combined with small lot for additional parking (TBD 2018?)

NEIGHBORHOOD COMMITTEE MEETINGS:

In conjunction with the Neighborhood Light Committee meetings, the Neighborhood Parking Committee shall also meet prior to the spring and fall seasons. Additional meetings, if necessary shall be scheduled as needed.
