- IV. East Branch DuPage River Trail members provided a presentation on the group's mission and summarized the intent to construct a 28-mile regional trail that connects the Great Western Trail near Butterfield Road and Morton Arboretum. Currently, a preliminary engineering and alignment study is underway to understand the feasibility of constructing the project. The Glen Ellyn Park District contributed \$3,000 to that effort.
- V. The District's 2019 Environmental Goals were shared with the group.
- VI. Earth Day plans were outlined. This year's event will be co-presented with SCARCE and include green vendors, mini-workshops, guided tours, children's activities, D41's student expo of environmental projects, live music, two food trucks, and canoe rentals.
