- Explore sharing/joint contracting of select operational functions with other governmental units (e.g., Village, school districts). Examples include:
 - o IT
 - Hardware procurement
 - Software licensing
 - Services (e.g., application support & hardware support, cybersecurity, end user support)
 - o Legal services
 - o Accounting/audit services
 - o Insurance
 - o Selected maintenance services (e.g., custodial services, lawn mowing)
 - o Grant applications
- Establish a volunteer subject matter expert (SME) advisory corps – This would include GEPC residents with experience and expertise in selected areas (e.g., grant writing, IT, project management, marketing, etc.) that GEPC may call on periodically for advice or assistance on a limited scope basis (e.g., development/review of an RFP, marketing a new program).
