### **OVERVIEW**

The design process began with three community focus group meetings. The groups of stakeholders included Operations and Advocacy groups, local and small Business owners, and Arts, Events, and Programming professionals from the Glen Ellyn community. The consultant team then went to the public, hosting booths at both the Summer Break at the Lake event, as well as National Night Out. Throughout the engagement process, over eight hundred (800) digital surveys were collected after each Open House.




